Anti-Violence, Gender Equality Promotion and Strategy (1-2 days)

An overview of the causes and contributing factors of gender-based violence, ways to identify it and how to respond as individuals. The stakeholder group will also work to create a plan to prevent and respond to violence against women in their workplace and for their workers which could include the institution of policy and procedure. In these sessions, we also work with staff to identify how we could create more equitable standards within the workplace and address norms and practices that may be harmful to both genders.

Child Protection Training (1-2 Days)

Provides stakeholders with the necessary information and skills to identify acts of violence and abuse against children. After completing the course, the participants will be able to respond effectively to cases of child abuse in their own lives. The staffing group will also work on a plan to create a child-safe work environment and sign on to a child protection policy and code of conduct that outlines appropriate behaviours when working with children.

Respectful Relationships Education (2 days - 8 weeks)

EPF is a global leader in respectful relationship education. We can establish projects to promote respectful relationships for the children of staff or the youth in catchment/project sites to support the establishment of happy and healthy future generations. We explore violence, equality, seeking help, consent and work to empower the next generation of change.

Design Thinking for Positive Change (1-5 Days)

Design thinking is a non-linear, iterative process that teams use to understand beneficiaries, challenge assumptions, redefine problems and create innovative solutions to prototype and test. Involving five phases—Empathize, Define, Ideate, Prototype and Test—it is most useful to tackle problems that are ill-defined or unknown. Making it extremely useful in complex settings. EPF believes it's an antidote to many top-down approaches to development, that do not consult appropriately with or utilize the strengths of the public.
